**Haskins Forest Lodge Garden Centre**

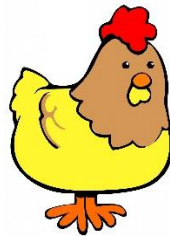
We are thrilled to say that Haskins Forest Lodge have chosen us to be their charity. They have also kindly donated items for the garden such as small greenhouses and hand tools.

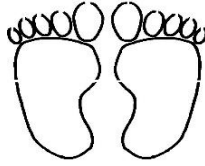
